Greetings, prayer and support Partners!

The past two months have been filled with activity, as well as challenges. We had a nice, but rushed visit with family just before Christmas. My wife, Luke, and I arrived back in Homestead exhausted, but before going to bed I noticed that one side of my face was drooping and my speech was slurred. I had a mild case of Bell's Palsy.
