**Chinese Church Report.**

From the beginning of our Chinese work in Pyungtaek, Korea, I have been praying God to help and allow us to have a Bible study or discipleship program for these Chinese Christians so that they would grow in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But because of the language barrier and lack of proper material in Chinese, I only had this desire until Jeon-bok Kim was introduced to our ministry. He is a Korean Chinese young man, and he is very fluent in both Korean and Chinese languages. And as Brother and Mrs. Jeong-bok Park, former missionaries to China comes to help us as much as they could, we were able to start a Saturday afternoon bible study in June. I have men's class with my interpreter sitting across me. Mr. Jang-ping Yi is a faithful believer and brother in Christ. He has a desire to learn the Bible and grow in Christ.

Mrs. Park, who is not so fluent in Chinese language, is trying hard to work with several ladies. It is great joy to see these young Christians to gather together around to learn God and His truth from the Bible. I pray and ask the Lord to help them to be scripturally baptized soon. Please join us in prayers for their spiritual growth.

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> of June, I gave an invitation for salvation decision at the end of the service, these 5 ladies came to me and my interpreter to learn about God's salvation plan through Jesus Christ, and they all accepted the Lord as their Savior! We were thrilled for the grace of God and for the working of the Holy Spirit in spite of our weakness and limitedness.

It seems like we have to wait longer for a worker who would be able to take this Chinese ministry and build it to be more effective Church. Jae and I are studying Chinese language so that we would be able to communicate with these people. I may never be able to preach in Chinese, but I want to be able to talk with these precious people. Please pray that God would send a worker who would love and lead these people to spiritual growth and that this church would be used for the preaching of the gospel in main land China.
