September has been a particularly encouraging time in the work as we are now in our permanent store-front meeting house, we have seen new visitors, and new opportunities of outreach are opening.

During the month of August, we renovated and painted the interior of our newly leased meeting space. We held our first meeting in that location on Sunday, September 2nd and had two visitors—Mike and his son, Kale. This locates us along a major roadway going into the city centre and thousands of vehicles pass us daily. In the third week of September our new signage was installed, which includes a lighted pillar road-side sign, an awning sign over the front of our unit, and information lettering on our front door. Our literature has been reprinted to reflect the new location and meeting times. Our space gives us a main meeting room, a hospitality room, a storage room, a separate children's area, and restrooms.

Thank you to all our partner-investor churches. We thank the Lord God Almighty for moving this work forward. We want to say an extra thank you to those who have already sent special offerings, and to those whose offerings are still in route to us, for this store front renovation and start up. There are a few pictures attached. My home church supplied us with chairs and covered liability insurance—thanks all. All monies designated for the store front start up will be used for that. ALL NATIONS BAPTIST CHURCH-MISSION now has a visible presence in the community.

We had held a Conversational English Chat Group in the early summer, but did not see anyone attend. We determined to try again in September. On September 10 we saw four adult visitors (5 children), and on September 26 we had one adult (3 children). Some of the previous attendees had to work that night. There appears to be building interest and we have the next meeting already scheduled.

Pray for the souls of Mike and his son, Kale, and a man named for Ian; as well as the people attending the English Chat Group—that their hearts would be opened and that we would have the boldness to speak the gospel as we ought. Ben and Bitna Lim are growing in their walk with the Lord and just announced that the Lord has blessed them with a child, pray for them. There is much work to be done and the need of God's gracious strength in which to do it. We covet your prayers.

I am planning a mini-furlough in Spring 2019. The Lord has given me peace about it, my Pastor and church are behind it, and our team situation gives me an extra liberty, as the work here will not be held back by a short absence. As missions knowledgeable people know there is always an attrition of partners and we are seeking to have the Lord add more partners to this work. I will endeavour to report to a portion of our current partners and to visit new prospects. If I do three month mini-furloughs over the next two or three years I will be able to report to all our faithful partners and then be set for future
