Geumgang BBC is getting ready to start its ministry in March. As we are preparing this new ministry, we began to have services from the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of this year. There were 13 people on the first Sunday at the new location and we trying to fix the place and get ready for the Start Sunday on March 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please pray that this new church would glorify God and be used for the souls in the area. We could order and put up the signage last month. We are very grateful for the helps from our supporting churches. We still have many things to do this month. Please pray that God would supply our needs and help us as the Lord leads you for the various needs of this new church plant.

**APRIL 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2019 - CHINESE CHURCH'S SEOUL TRIP.**

It takes 10-12 hours to travel by the ferry boat between Shantung Peninsula of China and Pyungtaek port of Korea. From the beginning of this ministry in 2016, I've felt bad for our Chinese people because they travel all the way to Korea on Saturdays and have to return on Sundays without having any chance to look around this beautiful country. So, I made a plan to take these people to a day trip to Seoul in April. We will have 2 large buses rented and take them as they disembark from the ferry on the 13th of April and take them to Kyungbok Palace, Seoul National Museum, and some other tourist attractions in Seoul. We will have lunch and preaching services in the bus, take them in a restaurant in Seoul for dinner, and watch the night view of Seoul city from Namsan(Southern Mt.), then return to our Church in Pyungtaek late for the night and rest. After the Sunday AM service at 8:00 on the next day, they will have to leave for China.

In order for them to have a chance to go on this trip free of charge, we began to have a point system with which they can earn points by scripture memorization and/or hand writing of Bible Chapters. They are very excited for this opportunity to have this trip and we are very excited to see these people who have not had any chance to know the Bible in China quoting scriptures and writing these Bible chapters with their hands in their beautiful Chinese characters.

I am so thankful that the Lord has allowed us to have this Chinese ministry and see many of them accept the Lord as their Savior. I believe this trip will be a great blessing to their hearts too. I would need about \$3,000.00 for this project and would like to ask our supporting churches to help us as the Lord leads, so that they would see the love of our God and Lord Jesus Christ from our love and service for them.
