OUR CHINESE CHURCH'S SEOUL TRIP WAS A BLESSED TIME.

As I have talked to you in the last letter about the plan to take our Chinese people on a day trip to Seoul, we were able to take them to the capital city of S. Korea last Saturday, the 13th of April. There were 70 Chinese people and 6 workers and drivers in two 45 passenger buses. They got on board as they left their boat from China and it took more time than we anticipated. The traffic in Seoul was horrible because a great mass of people were out to demonstrate their complaints against the government. This was a new experience to these people, because you cannot see such things in their country. Because of this, the buses were not able to get to the Kyungbok Palace's parking area. We had to get off at a corner several blocks away from the palace gate. We all had to walk along the busy Gwanghwamun Boulevard to enter the palace. I had purchased red baseball caps to distinguish our people among the tourists. And it proved to be a good idea.

Once we got to the palace, we all had wonderful time looking around the beautiful old buildings where Kings and governors had worked and lived during the past many centuries. The weather was perfect and they all enjoyed very much taking pictures and finding interesting things about the old Korea. The palace supplied two Chinese speaking guides for our group. Everybody enjoyed it very much and we all had a wonderful time. I'd like to say thank you to the friends who helped us financially for the needs of this trip.

Even though Jae and I do not speak Chinese language, we love them very much and they know it and they are learning about the love of God. 5 more Chinese people accepted the Lord into their hearts since our last letter. To God be the glory!

We are very grateful that the Lord led us to do this ministry and that you are praying and holding ropes for us. May the Lord bless you with abundant fruits that remain forever in His vineyard!
