Dear Pastors, Churches, and Friends.

SAFELY RETURNED HOME.

After 2 months of short but fruitful furlough, we are very happy to be back home. Jae and I are glad to join once again with our people who were waiting eagerly for our return and it was a joyful time to have service together in Church.

The Lord has been good to us for these months and churches and God's people were kind and generous toward our needs for Church building. About \$160,000 has come in so far and we are praying the rest, \$140,000, would come by the end of this month so that we would be able to close the transaction of purchasing \$1.3 million church building, by the grace of God, in November, 2021.

PARSONAGE REMODELING STARTED.

Upon our arrival, the family at the church vacated the place so that we would be able to work on the parsonage. We hired a contractor, who is a brother in Christ from Mogpo BBC which we started 41 years ago. We expect the work done by the end of this month and we will move in and settle down to work for the new phase of our ministry.

BRO. SEONGGYU YOON HEADED TO HEARTLAND BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE.

Bro. Yoon has faithfully worked as an assistant to pastor for almost 6 years and now he is preparing to go to Heartland BBC in Oklahoma City, OK for further training from the Spring semester of 2022. That means we would need another assistant for our ministry. Please pray the Lord would bless Bro. Yoon as he goes forward for the calling of God for his life, and He would send us a right man to replace him.

BRO. PARK GOT DEVELOPED SHINGLES AND UNDER TREATMENT.

I was not feeling right at the end of furlough and found rashes around my low back. I did not go to see a Dr. in the States thinking it was not serious, but when I saw a Dr. here in Korea, I learned that I have developed shingles. Because of our trip to overseas and for the fear of COVID-19, hospitals were reluctant to treat me, and finally, by a referral of a hospital staff, a Dr. in a University Hospital in town saw and began to treat me from Oct. 5th. It seems it might take for a while to get healed because the treatment began late and shingles spread widely.

Geumgang BBC, Jae, and I are very thankful for all the churches and friends who generously participated in our building project and pray the Lord recognize and reward you for all the sacrifices you have made. We still need more help, but the Lord has promised that He would fulfill it and He has been doing it, so may the name of God lifted and glorified! If you have not made a contribution toward this, I humbly ask you to pray and help us as the Lord leads and be a part in this blessed project.
