But the Lord has been good to us as we serve Him and His people in this wonderful country. For the last 2 months God has blessed us with 2 souls saved and 4 people baptized.

On the last week of July, as I asked you to pray for in the last letter, we had our Summer Family Camp with the theme of "Remove not the Ancient Landmark". Brother Yoon and I taught messages and lessons on the Biblical principles and values that we should not move or change as well as our Baptist Distinctives.

There were not as many people attended as I hope and prayed, but it was a time of refreshing, challenge, and edification for those attended. Thank you for your prayers and please keep praying for Daepyeong Bible Baptist Church so that we would be able to reach Sejong City for the Lord.

### SEJONG COMMON CAMPUS FOR UNIVERSITIES OPEN.

As I have told you several times in our past letters, Sejong city is recently developed for S. Korean government and administrations. Since it is a baby city, for more than 10 years, we had to travel to other nearby cities for hospital, department stores, and/or other accommodations. And as the city is getting shaped, we now have a general hospital, and a "COSTCO", but no department store yet. One of the things we have waited and hoped to have was a college campus.

On Sept. 2nd, 2024, Sejong Common Campus for Universities was open about 10 minutes away from our church. This is a campus with multiple educational buildings and labs being constructed to be used to teach and to train students from 5 national universities. Seoul National University, Chungnam N. U., Chungbuk N. U., Hanbat N. U., and KDI(Korea Development Institute) School of Public Policy and Management will use these campus and facilities together for the education of their students.

From the beginning of our ministry in S. Korea, we have been praying the Lord would allow us to have a ministry for college students. A statistic says only 2-3% of college age Korean young people go church. It is a big mission field. When Brother Yoon returned from the States after his graduation from Heartland Baptist Bible College last May, I have told him to focus and plan to have a ministry for college and career young people.

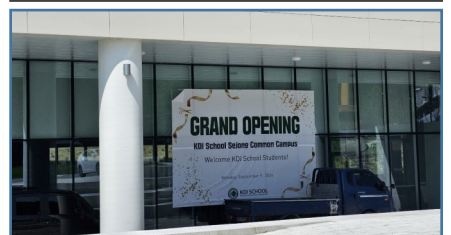
