I understand that the United States Postal Service is not accepting mail addressed to Canada while the Canada Post strike is ongoing, for obvious reasons. May I recommend that each church hold onto our support until this strike is over, at which time I will notify you. I have a contingency/emergency savings-fund that will, Lord willing, take us into February 2025. We are praying that the Lord will end this strike for us long before that. If it happens to last unusually long, we will have to arrange something, by God's grace.

Thank you for all your praying. Daniel, mentioned in our last letter, to whom I was enabled to give the gospel, unfortunately, has moved on. Please continue to pray for Rogan and Molly, as well as another couple that has been coming, Brandon and Jenna. These are both young married couples. Please continue praying for Tim. These all come from neo-evangelicalism, and it takes time and patience to teach them the gospel, to teach faith in God's Word and not feelings, verify that they are born-again, and begin to lay further foundations in sound doctrine. We are so grateful to our Lord for the open doors before us into these people's lives. We love each person whom the Lord gives to us and labour and pray to see Christ formed in them by the power of God, through His Word.

Our Campus Bible Study is going well. A couple of those students have also come out to our Sunday evening preaching meeting. Pray for these student's souls—particularly for <u>Willow</u>, and for <u>Samuel</u>. We are also now <u>adding a Sunday morning Bible doctrine class</u> and the two young married couples mentioned above are wanting to come to that, as well as our <u>mid-week Prayer meeting and Bible Study</u>.

I can do no better in closing this letter than exhort you with these holy words of our Lord through His servant and Apostle, Paul...

"And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light."
